Are you wanting or needing:

- 10 hours of Mentor coaching to apply for a credential or renew your existing one?
- To polish your coaching skills through observation of other's approach as well as get feedback on your own coaching?
- A more financially reasonable approach to any of the above?

Then you may be interested in the (generally) once a year Program led by Pat White. The objectives of this program are to provide:

- ✓ Guidance as you traverse one of the multiple approaches to an ICF credential
- ✓ Support for your individual skill development as a coach
- ✓ Camaraderie to motivate and encourage you to achieve your goals (think Mastermind).

The requirements are that you:

1. Have (or are able to shortly have) a minimum of 60 coach training hours completed
2. Be actively doing some coaching internally or externally
3. Commit to showing up on time for both sessions and be open and supportive of everyone in the group, including maintaining confidentiality.

Each group will be limited to 4-5 participants and offers 7 group coaching hours - the maximum allowed for group coaching by ICF. Members of this program will also have the option to contract with Pat White or other qualified mentor coaches to receive the additional 3 hours of one -on-one coaching (required by ICF) at a discount over the standard rate.

Groups will meet one Saturday in June & one Saturday in early July – time and dates to be determined by participants and coach. Participants should allow for four hours each time since breaks are included. All sessions will be at Pat White's home/office in Brentwood.

Investment: \$675.00 for seven hours of group coaching for ICF-TN or ICC members (less than \$100.00 per hour); non-members \$750.00.
